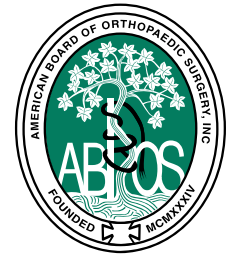


ABOS STRATEGIC PRIORITIES
