


ABOS KSB Participation Requirement:

- Beginning academic year 2025/2026: July 1, 2025
- Participation is required, not specific levels of achievement
- Resident must meet ABOS KSB participation requirements to be eligible for the ABOS Part I Board Certification Examination







Quick Guide and Tutorials




- ACGME ADS is still active for programs and residents to review reporting.
 - Case log data are available for ADS reporting within 48 hours of entry.
 - Do not wait until last minute to batch cases!
- Residents can modify any submitted case logs via the ABOS KSB+ app
 - Search Cases
 - Modify
 - •Changes sent to ACGME. To request a KSB assessment, a case must be entered within 48 hours of the date of that case.








Unexpected Pop Ups/Scenarios



If you are past 48 hours for Surgical Skills Request:

- 1. Pop-up appears
- 2. Uncheck box for KSB assessment
- 3. Submit



If you modify a previously submitted case (e.g. made an error in data entry)

- 1. Find case (search cases)
- 2. Choose Case
- 3. Change data element/s
- 4. Press Submit
- 5. ChangesSubmitted to bothACGME andABOS
- If assessment request change, must be done within 48 hours of case



Unexpected Pop Ups/Scenarios

"Your assessment request has NOT been sent to Dr. ABC. Please contact your residency program coordinator to add them as an attending in KSB+."

- Surgical Case was submitted to ACGME, but no surgical skill assessment submitted.
- Either program has not entered that individual in the KSB Faculty List or Duplicates in ADS system.


If a resident must rescind a Surgical Case submission (i.e.- case cancelled at last minute), find the incorrect submission, and simply "rewrite" over it with a new submission.


 There is no deleting surgical cases submitted, just the ability to over-write them and the ACGME/ABOS will receive the changes once they are submitted.




Resident Tracking Visuals (Starting July 1, 2025)

Upcoming Updates

Continued Collaboration with ABOS/ACGME to create an ABOS KSB+ Platform that reflects all recent ACGME updates.

- New ACGME Case
 Minimums have been
 reflected in ABOS KSB+
 app/webportal.
- Residents can now enter multiple codes in one log, and it will count as it needs to in ACGME.
- Use ACGME ADS to track your case minimum requirements.



FAOS

- Is ABOS KSB Program replacing ACGME Case Logs?
 - No, this is a collaboration.
- Should residents enter all their ACGME Case Logs through the ABOS KSB Program?
 - Yes
- Are all residency programs required to participate?
 - Yes, if there are residents that wish to be ABOS Examination Candidates.
- How do Program Directors and Program Coordinators review ACGME Case Log Data?
 - Continue to use ACGME ADS Case Log System.
- Who owns the data?
 - The data are owned by the ABOS. The ACGME Case Log data are owned by the ACGME.
- Do residents have to log a case within 48 hours?
 - If they want to request the corresponding ABOS KSB Surgical Skills assessment.
